# Professional Development

## STRENGTHENING TEACHING QUALITY THROUGH ASSESSMENT

NOVEMBER 15 & 28, 2025

November included two major initiatives focused on academic performance and instructional quality.



Later in the month, teachers completed the 4th Quarter Evaluation Test, with speaking assessments held throughout the week and written components finished on Friday evening and Saturday afternoon.

Excellence does not happen by chance—it is practiced, evaluated, and strengthened over time.

Whether in classrooms, auditoriums, or communities beyond campus, November reminded us of the value of connection—across countries, between educators and learners, and within neighborhoods shaped by resilience.

Education takes root through relationships, opportunity, and shared purpose. Each step we take, locally and internationally, reflects our commitment to opening doors for learners and building a culture grounded in support and possibility.

Both activities reinforced Philinter's belief in continuous improvement, ensuring teachers remain confident, informed, and aligned with the demands of contemporary language assessment.

The IELTS Trial Test by the British Council brought together 7 international staff and 10 new IELTS teachers for a half-day assessment on campus. The activity introduced participants to authentic test conditions, helping them deepen familiarity with examination standards and student expectations.
